

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What if I can't find the pricing for a particular health care service or procedure?

A. Please call the FMDH Price-Line at (406) 228-3511.

Q. Why do you only include an estimate rather than the exact price?

A. Actual charges vary depending upon many factors including, but not limited to:

- a) your physician's treatment choices
- b) actual services rendered
- c) the severity of the problem
- d) complexity of the procedure
- e) how long the procedure takes
- f) length of the hospital stay
- g) post-operative course

Q. If I have a surgical procedure done, are all of the costs included in the estimate?

A. The estimate will only include the hospital facility charges and the hospital anesthesia charge.

Q. Will my insurance affect the estimate?

A. Yes, if you have insurance coverage, your insurance policy (including deductibles, network coverage, copays, coinsurance, and out-of-pocket maximums) will help determine the amount you owe. For an estimate based on your insurance policy call the FMDH Price-Line at (406) 228-3511.
